



Can you refute the opposite side?

- John Stuart Mill (1806 1873): The most influential English-speaking philosopher of the 19th century
- * "He who knows only his own side of the case knows little of that. His reasons may be good, and no one may have been able to refute them. But if he is equally unable to refute the reasons on the opposite side, if he does not so much as know what they are, he has no ground for preferring either opinion"




Cognitive Dissonance

Mental discomfort when faced with contradictory beliefs . . .

John Swinton (1829 –1901)

- * Head New York Times editorial staff (1860), "guest of honour at a banquet given him by the leaders of his craft".
- * "There is no such a thing in America as an independent press, unless it is out in country towns. You are all slaves. You know it, and I know it. There is not one of you who dares to express an honest opinion. If you expressed it, you would know beforehand that it would never appear in print. . . . Our time, our talents, our lives, our possibilities, are all the property of other men. We are intellectual prostitutes."




* It's even worse now. Six media giants control 90% of what we read, watch or listen to.

Ted Olson contradicts FBI

Did your favorite news source report this?

- * "She called from the plane while it was being hijacked," Ted Olson said. (Wash Post, September 12, 2001)
- * The two conversations each lasted about a minute, said Tim O'Brien, a CNN reporter and friend of the Olsons (see <u>letter</u> to Wash Post)
- * Moments later, his wife called again. And again, she wanted to know, "What should I tell the pilot?"



BBC: Hijack 'suspects' alive Did your favorite news source report this?

- * "Saudi Arabian pilot Waleed Al Shehri was one of five men that the FBI said had deliberately crashed American Airlines flight 11 into the World Trade Centre"
- * "FBI Director Robert Mueller acknowledged on Thursday [September 20] that the identity of several of the suicide hijackers is in doubt."


- * The evidence against Bin Laden, promised by Secretary of State Colin Powell on September 23, 2001, has yet to be made available to the public.
- * "I am absolutely convinced that the al-Qaida network, which he [Osama bin Laden] heads, was responsible for this attack," Secretary of State Colin Powell said on NBC's "Meet the Press."



* Powell said the government would "put before the world, the American people, a persuasive case that ... it is al-Qaida, <u>led by Osama bin Laden</u>, who has been responsible."

Why 9/11 is still the issue

The 99% are being short-changed



- US plus allies account for 2/3rd world military spending
- Senate gave US \$82 billion boost
- * Russia entire budget is \$66 billion
- China to spend \$175 billion
- Military budget raised to \$716 billion
- * US total military budget (including for nuclear weapons and foreign wars) is about \$1 trillion . . . black budget?


President Eisenhower's warning

Military extravagance is depleting your wealth

- * On Jan. 17, 1961, President Dwight <u>Eisenhower</u> warned us about the military-industrial complex
- In the Eisenhower era, the United States, a creditor nation, produced at home the essentials oil, cars, televisions . . .
- * Today, we import far more than we export, with ever-increasing <u>debt</u>
- Military extravagance is depleting rather than adding to the nation's wealth
